Hinging

Doors over 36" Tall will be Bored for 3 Hinges.

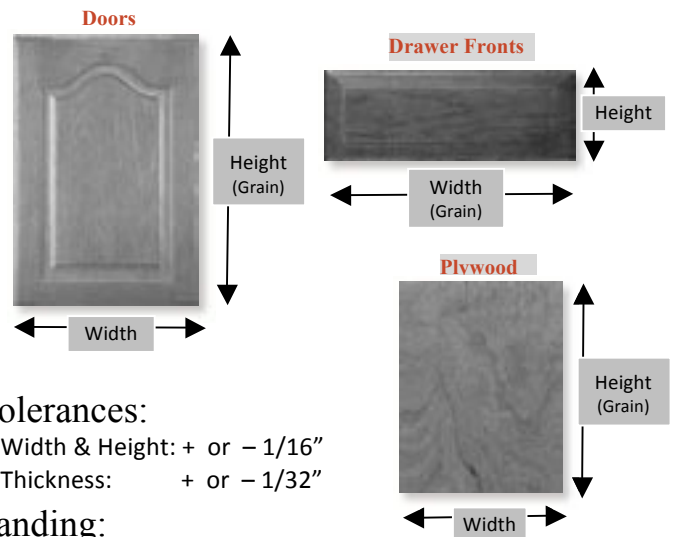
Bore (B1 or B2)... 3 holes drilled on back of door for each hinge, 1 large hole for hinge cup and 2 small holes for Dowel (B1) or Pilot (B2) Holes.

Bore Left (HL)... Looking at front of door, bore holes are on back left side of door.

Bore Right (HR)... Looking at front of door, bore holes are on back right side of door.

Bore Pair (HP)... Boring of two doors covering one opening, one bored left and one bored right.

Hanger Holes... Two small 1/8" diameter holes drilled on back side of door, to hang door while finish is applied.

Drawer fronts: Drawer fronts less than 8" in height and 30" in width are warranted against warpage of more than 1/4". Drawer fronts more than 8" in height (across the grain) or 30" in width (with the grain) are not warranted. Warranty: Warranty covers replacement of door and shipping only.
